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Street Parade 2026

Techno, sunshine, and pure joy of life

The 33rd Street Parade was a resounding success: Around 900,000 visitors partied exuberantly in bright sunshine and sweltering 33° heat to the beats of 26 Love Mobiles and nine stages. Zurich was once again transformed into the center of the global techno movement. The atmosphere was cheerful and peaceful, with no major incidents reported so far.

The first of the 26 Love Mobiles set off right on time at 2:00 p.m. from Zurich's Seefeld district on the two-kilometer route—and plunged into a sea of some 900,000 visitors. Whether dressed in flashy, extravagant, or casual attire, young people and the young at heart from all over the world flocked to the city on the Limmat to celebrate together. The atmosphere was fantastic and peaceful, and so far the event has proceeded without any notable incidents. Under the motto "Together we move," the dancing crowd celebrated the joy of life in downtown Zurich. This year's Love Mobiles, designed as always by the electronic music scene, were colorful, stylish, and creative. Numerous young Love Mobile teams and DJs made their debut this year and are likely to breathe new life into the Street Parade—pointing to a promising future. With sounds ranging from melodic techno to hardstyle, the Love Mobile creators once again served up the full spectrum of danceable electronic music. The last mobile crossed the finish line at 10:00 p.m., and the music on the stages was turned off at midnight.
